

KVH Assists in Chinese Earthquake Relief

On May 12, a massive earthquake destroyed a large portion of China's Sichuan Province, causing tens of thousands of casualties and injuries and inestimable property loss and damage. This event also shook the hearts of people around the world, including some very ambitious and generous employees at KVH. Senior RF engineer Bosui Liu did some research, and then asked his fellow employees at KU to help the victims of this unthinkable disaster with monetary contributions. The result was a sizeable donation that helped many families in Sichuan Province.
