



2019 A.H. Kits van Heyningen Technology Scholarship Application

As a high-tech company, KVH relies on the innovation and skill of its employees to develop award-winning, industry-leading products for markets and customers worldwide. In recognition of the importance that scientists, technicians, engineers, artists/designers, and mathematicians play in the current and future success of our company, KVH will award a two-part scholarship to a graduating high school senior who will be attending a four-year undergraduate science, technology, engineering, art/design, or math (STEAM) program in the fall of 2019; \$1,000 will be awarded before the start of freshman year, and \$1,000 before the start of sophomore year, contingent on enrollment confirmation both years. In addition to the monetary award, the KVH scholar will receive preference for a paid internship at KVH during the summers before their junior and senior years. While the scholarship is not solely need based, preference will be given to students who demonstrate a financial need. The scholarship is named for Mr. A.H. Kits van Heyningen, KVH's late co-founder and chief scientist.

Student Qualifications

The student chosen to receive this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- S/he must be a graduating high school senior who will be attending a four-year undergraduate program for the purpose of studying science, technology, engineering, art/design, or math, and have an unweighted GPA of at least 3.0
- S/he must be either:
 - a resident of Aquidneck Island or attend an Aquidneck Island high school; or
 - the son, daughter, or grandchild of a current KVH employee

Applying for the Scholarship

To be considered for the A.H. Kits van Heyningen Technology Scholarship, applicants must submit:

- High school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation (at least one from a science, technology, engineering, art/design, or math teacher)
- Essay (300 words minimum) – Why do I want to continue my education in a STEAM subject?
- Personal and financial information (see following page)
